What: Gloria Steinem speaks in Mississauga on Thursday, May 10th, 2007, from 12 noon to 1:30 p.m. at the Mississauga Convention Centre. One of the world's most well known spokespersons for women's rights, Ms. Steinem has been ridiculed, reviled, and revered for her famous efforts to achieve equality for women over the past 40 years. Ms. Steinem has a unique story to tell – a story that will inspire and challenge women and men alike.

Who: Gloria Steinem, best known as a founder of *Ms. Magazine* and feminist activist, now travels the world as an organizer and lecturer and is a frequent media spokeswoman on issues of equality.

A best selling author, Ms. Steinem's books include *Revolution from Within: A Book of Self-Esteem*, *Outrageous Acts and Everyday Rebellions*, *Moving Beyond Words*, and *Marilyn: Norma Jean, on the life of Marilyn Monroe*.

Gloria Steinem is also a founder of *New York Magazine* and *Take Our Daughters to Work Day*. She has been the subject of Lifetime and ABC biographical television documentaries, and *The Education of a Woman*, a biography by Carolyn Heilbrun.

Ms. Steinem's awards include Lifetime Achievement in Journalism Award from the Society of Professional Journalists, the Society of Writers Award from the United Nations, and the Ceres Medal from the United Nations. Parenting magazine selected her for its Lifetime Achievement Award for her work in promoting girls' self-esteem, and Biography magazine listed her as one of the 25 most influential women in America.
